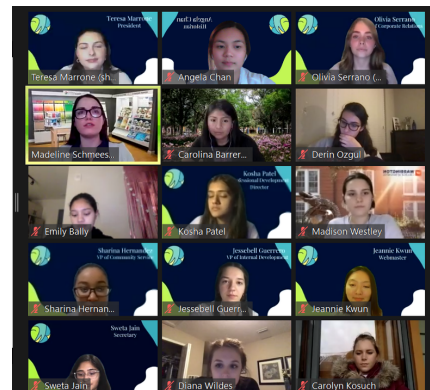


March Highlights
