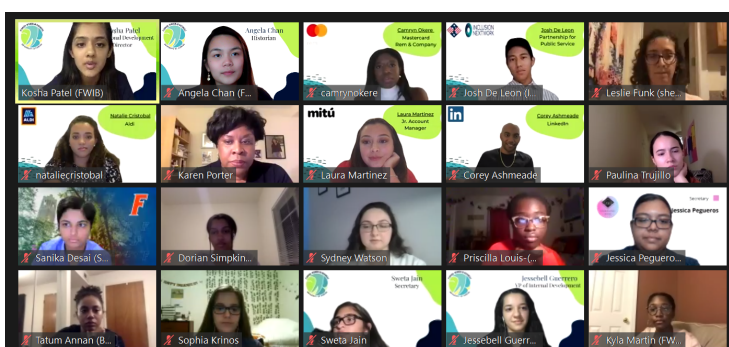


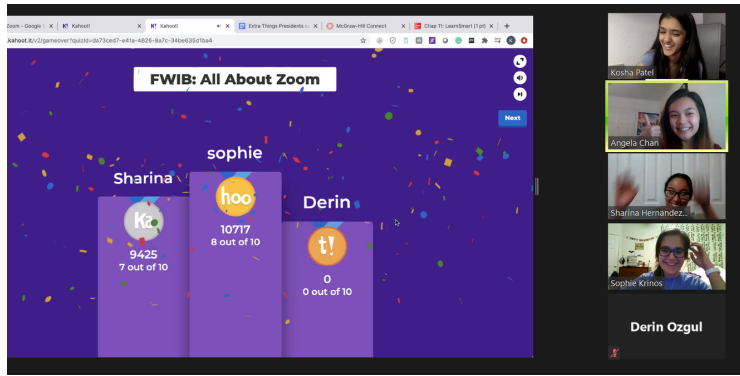
November Highlights

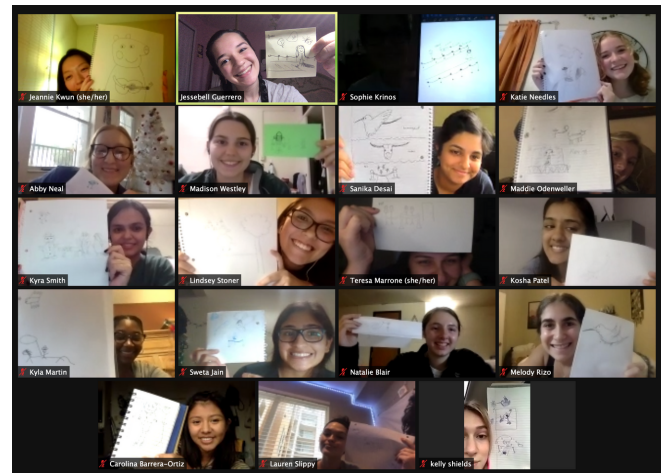
