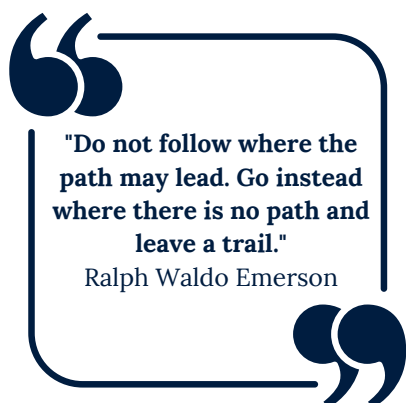


Community Service
